Nonprofit Offerings



Project Advance AmeriCorps has openings for 2 partner sites to host AmeriCorps members this fall.

Our AmeriCorps members sign up to serve 11 months (Sept. 2019 through July 2020) at entry level social service positions in order to build their resume and gain experience. The host site pays \$11,000 to host the AmeriCorps member. The members help provide entry level services to the agency clients.

We seek partner sites where the member can help provide services to low income clients in

health, education, housing or employment related programs. The members need to spend most of their 40 hour service week providing direct services to clients, (not administrative or clerical roles). For more information, click HERE


